Join us for a fun session of helping adults and kids learn how to look up relatives using the Library's online genealogy program.

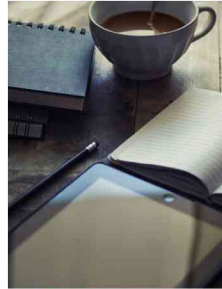
Tile Art* Thursday, May 23 6:30 - 7:30 p.m.

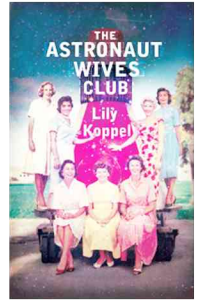


Local author Larry Michaels will talk about his experiences through publishing several books. Refreshments will be provided and questions are encouraged.

Come Meet Princess Jasmine and celebrate the release of the new *Aladdin* movie! There will be some royal snacks and activities for all ages!



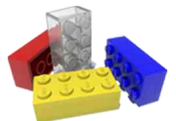
