**KIDS**

Join us this summer at the Clyde Public Library for our summer reading program! Summer Reading is free and open to all children (ages 0 - 11). Weekly programs will begin the week of June 6th and will include stories, crafts, guest speakers, and more. Weekly programs will be held on Mondays from 1:30 - 2:30 pm, Tuesdays from 6:30 - 7:30 pm, and Wednesdays from 10:30 - 11:30 am. Please register for programs by calling the library at 419-547-7174.

Children will earn tickets to enter for prizes by reading books and keeping track!! The library will provide reading tracker sheets at the children's desk, or we also provide an online option of keeping track called Beanstack. With Beanstack you can use the app or website to log your reading minutes/hours and information about books read. The more you read, the more tickets you earn towards prizes! All drawings for prizes will be done at the end of summer reading. All prizes must be picked up at the library.



**TEENS**

Teens will experience an "Ocean of Possibilities" this summer!! Teen Summer Reading will run from June 6th - July 29th, ending with an after-hours party for those who earned enough participation points! Teens will earn points and raffle tickets towards prizes by reading books and/or attending Summer Reading programming such as SPLAT, Teen Movie Club, and more. Points will be counted as participation to attend the after-hours party, and raffle tickets will count toward prize bundles. Prizes will be drawn at the end of Summer Reading.

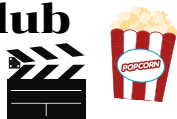

We hope you will join us! No registration required.

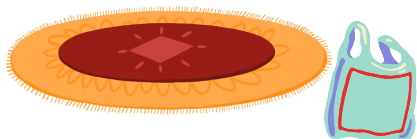
## DIY Eco Friendly Rug\*

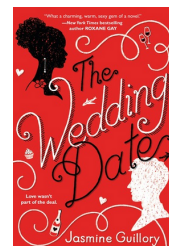

Weekly story time sessions are for children 2 - 6 years old. The 30-minute sessions include stories, finger-plays, music, art, movement, and language activities.

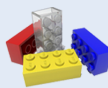
No pre-registration is required and parents are welcome to participate in story time with their child.
