## **No Shame, No Blame, No Overdue Fines! Starting Friday, February 1!**

Starting February 1, Clyde Public Library will be a fine-free Library! At their January meeting, the Library Board of Trustees voted to eliminate fines for most overdue books and materials, in addition to waiving current overdue fines for most Clyde Public Library materials throughout Clevnet. We want to increase access for patrons who cannot currently use our library's materials.

- Overdue fines will no longer apply to books and most materials in Clyde Library's collection (There are some exceptions: wifi hotspots and electronic equipment).
- Automatic renewals will still apply as long as an item has no holds and is renewable.
- Accounts with three or more overdue items will assume a temporary "suspended" status, and further checkouts will not be permitted until overdue items are returned.
- Lost or damaged items will still result in replacement or repair fees.
- This new policy applies only to items owned by the Clyde Public Library. Items owned by another Clevnet library are subject to that library's overdue policies.

When life gets in the way and you return items a few days late, you can do so without worrying about overdue fines. Even if you have an overdue item that prevents you from checking more items out, just return the item and you will be back to borrowing!

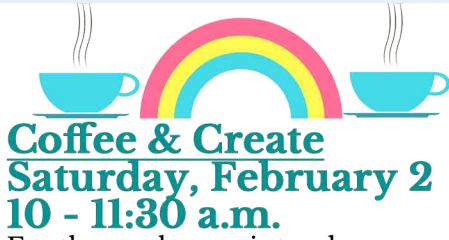

Internet Basics 2 focuses on email accounts. We will have a brief presentation on how to set up a new account. Please bring your log-in information with you for this class.

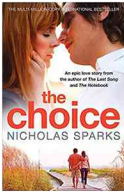

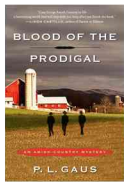

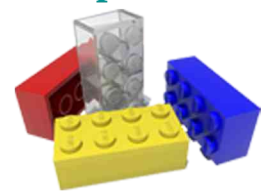
**Tuesday and Thursdays Story Time - Tuesdays at 4:00 p.m. and Thursdays at 11:00 a.m.**
